 - (b) In a suit the defendant refused to accept the summons which was issued to him. The process server left the summons on a table in the defendant’s house. Is the service valid?
 - (c) Chetan has taken a loan from Ganesh. He has given an acknowledgment to Ganesh before the expiry of limitation stating that, I owe you Rs. 50,000. But I refuse to pay the same”. Examine the validity of the acknowledgement.
