1. Examine the salient features of the Constitution of India.
2. Analyse the definition of the term 'State' as provided in Article 12 of the Constitution.
3. Discuss the scope of right to life and personal liberty under the Constitution.
4. Write short note on any one:
 - (a) Doctrine of Eclipse
 - (b) Fundamental Duties
5. Answer any one of the following with reasons:
 - (a) The Passport Authorities have refused to issue the Passport to 'A', a citizen of India, to go abroad. Can the Authorities be compelled to issue the passport? Decide.
 - (b) An Engineering College made admissions of candidates on the basis of oral interview after a written test. High marks were allocated for oral test and candidates were interviewed only for two or three minutes. 'A' got high marks in written test but low marks in oral test. He wants to challenge this. Decide.

 - (a) 'A' a government servant was appointed to officiate on a higher post. After one year, he was reverted to his original post on the ground of unsatisfactory work. 'A' challenges this under Art.311 of the Constitution. Decide.
 - (b) Mr. A's Government was dismissed by issuing State Emergency on the ground that he lost majority in the House without giving him an opportunity to prove majority in the House. Mr. 'A' challenges it. Decide.
