9. Solve any two of the following:
 - a) Mexico sent troops to protect three Americans from a mob in its territory. Instead of protecting them, the troops opened fire on the Americans and killed them. Is Mexico liable for the wrongs of the troops? Decide.
 - b) The Prince of state 'A' during his stay in state 'B' promises to marry a lady. Subsequently, he refuses to marry her. She wants to file a suit against him in state 'B'. Advice her.
 - c) State 'X' get 'A' extradited from state 'Y' on the ground that he had fled to 'Y' after murdering a fellow servant in a ship belonging to 'X'. In 'X', 'A' is tried not for murder but for causing grievous hurt to fellow servant. Is X's act justifiable. Decide.
