 - (b) Restitution of Conjugal Rights.
 - (c) Will.
9. Solve any two of the following problems:
 - (a) Radhika is working as a teacher in a Government School. Her husband who is unemployed filed a suit for maintenance against his wife. Is she liable?
 - (b) Raghavendra dies intestate in 2016 leaving his wife, mother, two daughters, two sons and his father. Distribute the estate among them.
 - (c) 'A' has two sons 'B' and 'C' and 'B' also has son and daughter. After sometime 'C' dies leaving behind his wife and property but 'B' commits the murder of 'A'. Can son and daughter of 'B' are entitled to get the property of 'A'.
