 - (b) A Mohammedan widow retained her husband's property in lieu of her dower amount. She is not ready to give up possession until her dower is paid. Can she do so?
 - (c) A Hanafi Muslim divorced his wife by Talaq. After sometime he wants to marry the divorced wife. Former wife also agreed to marry him. Can marriage between them is possible?
